

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ROANOKE BAR ASSOCIATION IN SUPPORT OF FILLING JUDICIAL VACANCIES IN THE TWENTY-THIRD JUDICIAL CIRCUIT

WHEREAS, two of the six Judges of the Twenty-Third Judicial Circuit have announced their plans to retire in the first half of 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that the loss of two judgeships will have a deleterious effect on the prompt resolution of disputes and the availability of justice for the citizens of the Twenty-Third Circuit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that it is the unanimous recommendation of the Board of the Roanoke Bar Association that the General Assembly fill at least one of the judicial vacancies as a matter of utmost urgency during its next regular session; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Legislators representing any portion of the Twenty-Third Judicial Circuit
